

2009 LOBSTERFEST REGULATIONS

Thank you for participating in Lobsterfest 2009, August 8th from noon until 11pm. Please read and (print if necessary) the below show rules to ensure everything runs smoothly.

Applications

Applications are due by July 8, 2009. No applications will be accepted after the deadline unless additional space is available. The Street Fair Committee reserves the right to refuse any application that is deemed unsuitable for the show. If your application is accepted, there will be NO REFUNDS of the show fee for cancellation due to illness, accident or weather. Should bad weather occur, please bring a tarp to protect your merchandise.

Cancellation Policy

No last minute cancellations/refunds will be permitted. Cancellations are permitted until 30 days prior to the event. Any cancellations/no shows after the deadline WILL NOT BE REFUNDED.

Payment

Payment for vendor space must be made via check or money order. All returned checks for payment will be subject to a \$20 service fee.

Booth Assignments

Every effort will be made to accommodate location requests on a first come first served basis. The earlier you get your application and payment in, the better chance you have of getting your request. No guarantees can be made regarding your booth location. Vendor space cannot be held without payment.

Exhibitors are responsible for their own tables, set-ups for their 10 foot space and breakdown. Canopies or umbrellas are permitted, but must not extend beyond the table or create a hazard for pedestrians. Merchandise must not extend beyond the outside of the booth. If electricity is required you will need to make arrangements with a nearby merchant. We are not responsible for providing electricity. No loud generators will be permitted.

Move in

All vehicles will travel Southbound only on Duval Street for move in. Vendors located in the 100 and 200 blocks of Duval Street designated as "A" or "B" and a number will enter from Front Street. Vendors located in the 300 or "C" block of Duval Street will enter from Caroline Street.

Set Up/Break down

The street will be closed for Lobsterfest by 9:00am. No booths will be set up before the streets have been closed by public works. This includes unloading your items on the sidewalks or blocking the street with your vehicle. If you are observed setting up your

booth before the streets have been closed you may be ticketed by the Key West Police Department.

All vendors/restaurants will begin breaking down their booths at 10:30pm. Each vendor is responsible for allotting a reasonable amount of time for break down. You each know how long it takes to complete this process so please allow for additional time if you have a lot of merchandise to wrap or pack. If your booth is not broken down by the designated time you will not be permitted to participate in future shows and may be subject to fines by Key West Police. Duval Street must be re-opened by 11:45pm. There are no exceptions!

Items Not Permitted for Sale by Vendors

The following items cannot be sold by vendors:

Alcoholic Beverages

Water/Soft Drinks

With the exception of dessert items, no food or beverage booths are allowed
